Directions to 861 (Wideopen) Squadron from A1/1056 junction

- Follow signs to B1318 Great North Road to Wideopen
- At the traffic lights/Travellers Rest pub junction, turn left onto Stalks Road
- Take the first left onto Canterbury Way and follow to a sweeping left hand turn
- Take next left onto Blanchland Avenue
- Left turn into Woodlands Hall car park
- Follow to the end of the car park – 861 Sqn HQ is located behind Woodlands Hall

Directions to 861 (Wideopen) Squadron from A19/B1318 junction

- Take 4th exit on the A19/B1318 roundabout marked Seaton Burn/Wideopen
- Follow the B1318 to the traffic lights/Travellers Rest pub junction, turn right onto Stalks Road
- Take the first left onto Canterbury Way and follow to a sweeping left hand turn
- Take next left onto Blanchland Avenue
- Left turn into Woodlands Hall car park
- Follow to the end of the car park – 861 Sqn HQ is located behind Woodlands Hall

Fire evacuation procedures

- Do not stop to collect any belongings
- Do not stop to collect a fire extinguisher
- Please remain at the Assembly Point while the register is called
